SANDALFORD Prendiville Cabernet Sauvignon 2002 is our wine this week. From the best of the 35-year-old cabernet blocks of Sandalford's 120ha of vines and from the 20 best barriques from a marvellous vintage from them, Sandalford has selected only 500 dozen of their finest cabernet base material to give Rolls-Royce treatment for this stunner.

It has archetypal Margaret River cabernet

sauvignon characters and is huge, ripe, fruit sweet and rich.

It has magnificent full, dense, succulent and long fruit characters.

At four years of age it can be consumed in a prestigious situation now.

The wine will also continue to improve for 20 years.

The packaging is as up-market as the wine.

This wine alters Sandalford's position in the Margaret River wine hierarchy.

And we reckon that other producers should be achieving at this level too.
